About Gift Aid

Gift Aid is a UK government scheme that enables registered charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASC) to claim the basic rate tax that you have paid on this donation. By being eligible and agreeing to Gift Aid, this In Memory Pages donation will increase in value by 25% (at current rates) so for every £10 you donate under Gift Aid, the charity will receive £12.50 ... but it won't cost you a penny more!
